


**Articulation Agreement of Academic Programs between
Urban College of Boston and University of Massachusetts, Boston**

The above institutions hereby enter into an agreement to facilitate the transfer of students enrolled in the **Associate of Arts in Early Childhood Education at Urban College of Boston** into the **Early Education & Care in Inclusive Settings BA** at University of Massachusetts, Boston.

University of Massachusetts, Boston's designated representative will be the Senior Associate Director, Transfer Admissions and Urban College of Boston's representative will be the Vice President for Academic Affairs and Workforce Development.





Objectives:

1. To attract qualified students to Urban College of Boston and University of Massachusetts, Boston.
2. To promote and facilitate an efficient transition of transfer students between institutions.
3. To provide specific information and guidelines for transfer students.
4. To encourage academic coordination and cooperation, including curricular reviews, on-site visits, and joint academic advising for students attending Urban College of Boston and University of Massachusetts, Boston.

Stipulations:

1. University of Massachusetts, Boston guarantees acceptance of Urban College of Boston students who complete the Associate's Degree with an overall GPA of 2.5, as outlined in this document.
2. Transfer students who follow the curriculum outlined in this agreement will not need to take more than 67 additional credits to receive a baccalaureate degree.
3. It is understood that students transferring from two-year colleges can bring a maximum of 70 transfer credits toward a UMass Boston degree. Students must complete at least 30 at UMass Boston to meet the residency requirement.
4. For a student to have a completed application to UMass Boston, they must submit official transcripts from all college/universities attended.
5. This agreement does not apply to students who previously matriculated at UMass Boston as a degree seeking student. Previous UMass Boston degree seeking students apply for re-enrollment through the UMass Boston Registrar's office and not through Undergraduate Admissions.

Mutual Responsibilities:

1. Both institutions agree to maintain current listings of the course equivalencies. This will be the responsibility of the two designated representatives.
2. Urban College of Boston and University of Massachusetts, Boston will incorporate a summary of this agreement into official publications and web sites.
3. Urban College of Boston and University of Massachusetts, Boston agree to encourage qualified students to participate in this program by providing information, advising, and other assistance required to foster a seamless transition from the two-year institution to the four-year institution.

Review/Revision:

1. This agreement will be reviewed every three (3) years and may be revised by mutual agreement.
2. This agreement is expected to continue in force indefinitely but may be terminated by either party with not less than one year's notice.

Articulation Agreement

Institution: Urban College of Boston

Transfer Institution: University of Massachusetts, Boston

Summary of Benefits:

- Guaranteed acceptance with a minimum G.P.A. of 2.5
- Guaranteed transfer of credits of all courses outlined in the curriculum chart with a C- or better.
- Students transfer with Junior status with regard to financial aid and registration
