


Study Abroad & Financial Aid Information Worksheet

This sheet includes the general information students should know when planning to use Financial aid to help fund study abroad. Circumstances can vary by student. You are responsible for ALL financial transactions associated with your study abroad program. Please note that financial aid processing for study abroad takes time. Documents are processed in the order that they are received, and you are responsible for providing all necessary documentation to the Office of Global Programs (OGP) and the Financial Aid Office. Budgeting for your Program:

Budgeting is a major part in preparing to go abroad. Use this sheet to help estimate the total cost of studying abroad and begin looking at your current funding sources. Consult with the <u>Office of Global Programs</u> and your program for estimated expenses, and their due dates. Check your UMass Boston WISER for your current financial aid awards, or contact your <u>financial aid advisor</u> to help you find this information and fill out this budget worksheet.
